Available through KWC at favorable rates or from contractors we can recommend. A management plan is required for landowners to receive forestry management services. We can assist in:

- development of management plans for Managed Forest Law (MFL), stewardship, or tree planting
- timber sale administration
- meeting your objectives for sustainable management, ecosystem restoration, or wildlife habitat development

Forestry Store

Our forestry store provides members with:

- access to forestry tools and books
- discounts on small tool and safety equipment purchases
- discounts on winches, arches, and chippers
